Notice of Race

- 1. Rules
 - 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined by the racing rules of sailing.
- 2. Alterations to racing rules
 - 2.1 protests will be sorted out below the low watermark and the result will be reported to the race committee. Be respectful
- 3. Eligibility and Entry
 - 3.1 The regatta is open to Wing Foilers only
 - 3.2 competitors must be able to foil jibe
 - 3.3 entries will be limited to 130
 - 3.4 all entry fees must be paid by 11 100 hours on the day of competition
- 4. Racing schedule
 - 4.1 Friday 24 January 2025

Noon – Briefing

13:00 –Subject to wind, short course racing (Banging the Corner Cup)

Racing will be by age group with a maximum of 30 sailors in each group

Format will be a knockout series until the top five are determined

1800 – Shared Meal at BOIYC. Cost \$19.00 to be paid at the bar. Menu is cook your own steak and salads and chips

- 8.2 Banging the Corners is a knock out series
